

CSO Comments on FP067 WFP Tajikistan (BM19, March 2018)

Building climate resilience of vulnerable and food insecure communities through capacity strengthening and livelihood diversification in mountainous regions of Tajikistan

We support this community based adaptation project particularly because it targets smallholder farmers and has made a substantial effort to get community buy-in and stakeholder input.
